**Proposal for setting up a Computer Centre for Development.
In the premises of Government Secondary and Higher
Secondary Ashram School Piwali, Shahapur, Thane**

Sector: Quality education in the educationally backward tribal Block of Piwali, Shahapur

Primary Beneficiaries: 408 tribal students from BPL families.

Target Group:

The beneficiaries comprise of 198 male and 210 female students studying up to 10th standard and belonging to tribal families. The aim of the project is to improve the learning outcomes of first- generation learners in this predominantly tribal area.

Literacy rate –

The literacy rate of Shahpur Taluka is 65.98% out of which 73.23% males are literate and 58.41% females are literate. The total area of Shahapur is 1,616.16 sq.km with population density of 194 per sq.km. Out of total population, 77.49% of population lives in Urban area and 22.51% lives in Rural area. The average literacy rate in urban areas is 86.5% while that in the rural areas is 72.8%

Executive summary:

Shahapur is a town and census town in Thane district in the Indian state of Maharashtra. Shahapur is surrounded by the Western Ghats.

Piwali is a Village in Shahapur Taluka in Thane District of Maharashtra State, India. It belongs to Konkan Region. It is located 70 KM towards East from District headquarters Thane. 8 KM from Shahapur .92 KM from State capital Mumbai. There is no railway station near to Piwali in less than 10 km.

Education in the tribal context

The educational status of tribal communities needs to be understood within a socio-economic context, in which survival and basic requirements of food, health and shelter

continue to be grave challenges as several studies show. It is for this very reason that the Maharashtra Government has constructed Ashram Shala's (residential schools) for tribal children providing them with free food, lodging and education. However, merely constructing Ashram Shala's is not enough, the availability of competent teaching staff has to be addressed, which is what Life Saver Foundation is attempting to do by providing extra coaching to the students through its Centre for Development model.

Piwali village has been notified as an Educationally Backward Block

A special effort will be made to help these students improve in difficult subjects like mathematics, science and English.

Key features of the Centre for Development:

1. Supportive classes will be provided to the 408 beneficiaries to help them improve in difficult to learn subjects like mathematics, science and English.
2. A good library with books and magazines for students and teachers will be set up.
3. E-learning kits will be provided to the school.

The Centre for Development in Piwali Village will serve as a Benchmark of Excellence and it is a pioneering initiative of Life Saver Foundation.

Project Context and Rationale:

- Literacy in India as per the latest ASER (Annual Status of Education Report) 2013.
- Almost 68% Children in standard 3rd in Government schools, cannot read 1st standard level text
- Almost 60% children in standard 5th in Government schools, cannot read 2nd standard level text
- Around 79% children in standard 5th cannot do mathematical problems.
- In arithmetic, a large fraction of children are lagging several years behind compared to where they are expected to be. Around 50% of Schools do not meet pupil teacher ratio norms as per RTE.

Project Intervention and Objectives:

In the light of the above it becomes imperative for immediate intervention to bring about a change in the quality of education for the 408 children studying in the schools in Piwali . The programme will be scaled up to accommodate students from other classes (subject to corporate funding).

The Centre for Development has the following objectives:

- Providing e-learning kits for better learning outcomes and encouraging self-study.
- Giving a special emphasis on teaching science, mathematics and English. If required, bridge-courses may be introduced for weaker students.
- Setting up a good library with books and magazines for students and teachers.
- Conducting interschool competitions to judge the efficacy of the teaching modules.
- Ensuring that the students reach the requisite competency levels. This will help them appear for and clear professional entrance examinations once they pass out of 12th standard.

Expected Project Outcomes:

- Improved learning outcomes of 408 first-generation learners studying in the above-mentioned school.
- 80% of the students will secure higher marks in challenging subjects like mathematics, science and English.
- Improved self-esteem and ability to communicate in English.
- Improved levels of motivation that will drive them to continue with their higher studies.

Deliverables:

- Quarterly utilization certificates (UC) and final UC after project completion.
